



**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
REGARDING REGISTRY FUNDS**

The Court has been advised by the Clerk of Court that, in the interest of more efficient and effective administration of the Court's registry funds, which are now deposited in various banking institutions across the Western District of Texas, the registry funds should be centrally controlled and handled by the financial staff assigned in the headquarters office in San Antonio, using the Court Online Banking (COLB) system available at the Bank of America. A centralized system will expedite the process of depositing and disbursing of funds, without the need for additional court orders or coordination with multiple banking entities. The Clerk of Court has advised that earnings on these funds are likely to exceed any interest now being offered by the present depository.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of Court is authorized and directed to take such steps as may be required to transfer all monies now on deposit in various financial institutions across the district to the Court Online Banking (COLB) system at Bank of America. The Clerk is further authorized to release its claim on all collateral presently pledged by those financial institutions to the court as security, and to execute such documents as are necessary to effectuate that release.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk of Court is authorized to deposit all future court registry funds into the COLB system at Bank of America upon receipt, without further order of this court.
