

CLEARING YOUR CACHE

Too many temporary internet files stored on your computer can sometimes cause problems. The court recommends that you clean out your temporary internet files frequently. Here is how you can make the process automatic.

If You Use Internet Explorer 6 and 7:

1. Click on the Tools hyperlink.
2. Click to select Internet Options in the drop down box.
3. Click on the Advanced tab.
4. Under Security, click to place a check in the “Empty Internet Files folder when browser is closed” checkbox.
5. Click [Apply], then click [Close].

If You Use Firefox:

1. Click on the Tools hyperlink.
2. Click to select Internet Options in the drop down box.
3. Click on the Privacy tab.
4. Under Private Data, click to place a check in the “Always clear my private data when I close Firefox” checkbox.
5. Click the [Settings] button next to the “Always clear my private data when I close Firefox” checkbox.
6. Click to place a check in the “Cache” checkbox then click [OK].
7. Click [OK] on the privacy screen.
