
IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. *Administrative Procedures for Filing, Signing and Verifying Pleadings and Papers by Electronic Means* in this court, including the procedure for registration of attorneys and for distribution of passwords to permit electronic filing and notice of pleadings, and other papers, are hereby approved by the court.

The provisions of this Order shall apply to all electronically filed cases and proceedings presently pending or subsequently filed in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Texas. Amendments to this Order may be entered from time to time in keeping with the needs of the court.
