 - (2) One hundred percent (100%) of all pending cases and proceedings previously assigned to Vacant Judge.

- (a) San Antonio Division
 - (1) One hundred percent (100%) of all pending cases and proceedings previously assigned to Vacant Judge;
 - (2) Sixty percent (60%) of all newly filed cases (all chapters).

- (b) Any case in a single bankruptcy judge division in which a bankruptcy judge is disqualified or in which he recuses himself, will be handled by another bankruptcy judge;
- (c) With respect to each division in which business is assigned to more than one bankruptcy judge, all cases shall be allocated pursuant to the percentages set forth above and shall be assigned randomly;
- (d) This order supersedes similar orders of the Court on assignment of the business of the Court;
- (e) This Order shall become effective on April 1, 2013;
