


ORDER ADOPTING CHANGES TO LOCAL RULES

Whereas, new amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure go into effect on December 1, 2009; and

Whereas, these new amendments implement a new consistent method for calculating time periods throughout the federal rules, counting every day, including weekends and holidays, and adopting standard periods in increments of 7 days; and

Whereas, it is the duty of the Court to ensure its Local Rules are in conformity with national rules and federal statutes;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. section 2071, Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 9029 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, this Court ADOPTS changes to the Local Rules of The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Texas, and Appendices thereto, as set forth in the attached Exhibit A, effective December 1, 2009.

EXHIBIT A TO STANDING ORDER ADOPTING CHANGES (12-1-09)

Rule 1001

In § (d), remove paragraph discussing “interim rules.”

In § (h), remove the reference to “interim rules.”

Rule 1007

In § (b) change “fifteen (15) days” to “fourteen (14) days.”

Remove § (c).

Rule 1019

Change all time period references of “fifteen (15) days” to “fourteen (14) days.”

Rule 2002

In § (b) in the phrase “The notice required under 11 U.S.C. § 342(b) **to given** by the clerk...” revise “to given” to read “to be given.”

Rule 2004

In § (b), change time period from “fifteen (15) days” to “fourteen (14) days”, and “five (5) calendar days” to “three (3) calendar days.”

In § (d) change “fifteen (15) days” to “fourteen (14) days.”

Rule 2007.1

Strike § (c) as redundant with National Rule 2003(b)(3).

In § (d), change “ten (10) days” to “fourteen (14) days.”

Rule 2014

In § (d) change “twenty (20) days” to “twenty-one (21) days.”

In § (e)(1) change “20 day negative notice” to “21 day negative notice.”

Rule 3017

Strike “as amended by Interim Rule 3017.1.”

Rule 4001

In § (a)(1)(B) change “15 day negative notice language” to “14 day negative notice language.”
Change “fifteen (15) days” in the text of the notice language to “fourteen (14) days.”

In § (a)(1)(D)(ii) change “within 15 days” to “within 14 days.”

In § (e)(2) change “ten (10) days” to “fourteen (14) days.”

Rule 4002

In § (a)(1), in the phrase “Interim Rule 4002” strike the word “Interim.”

In § (b)(2), in the phrase “Interim Rule 4002(b)” strike the word “Interim.”

In §(b)(3) in the phrase “Interim Rule 4002(b)” strike the word “Interim.” Rule 4004In § (a), in the phrase “Interim Rule 4004(c)(1)(I), strike the word “Interim.”

In § (b), in the phrases “Interim Rule 1007(b)(8)” and “Interim Rule 2002(f)(11)” strike the word “Interim.”

In § (c)(1), in the phrases “Interim Rule 4004(c)(1)(H) and (I)” and “Interim Rule 2002(f)(11)” strike the word “Interim.”

Rule 5011

In § (c) change “ten (10) days” to “fourteen (14) days.”

Rule 7012

Change “20 days of service” to “21 days of service.”

Rule 7015

In § (d) change “ten (10) days” to “fourteen (14) days.”

Rule 7016

In § (a) change “ten (10) days” to “fourteen (14) days.”

In § (b) change “ten (10) days” to “fourteen (14) days.”

In § (f)(3) change “five (5) calendar days” “seven (7) calendar days.”

Rule 7026

In § (a) change “twenty (20) days” to “twenty-one (21) days.”

Rule 7054

In § (b) change “ten (10) days” to “fourteen (14) days.”

Rule 7056

Change “twenty (20) days” to “twenty-one (21) days.”

Rule 9014

In § (a) change “twenty (20) days” to “twenty-one (21) days.”

In the proposed order form language in § (e)(1) change “five (5) days” to “seven (7) days.”

In § (f)(4) change “five (5) days” to “seven (7) days.”

Rule 9015

In § (a)(2) change “fifteen (15) days” to “fourteen (14) days.”

In § (b) change “fifteen (15) days” to “fourteen (14) days.”

APPENDICES

Appendix L -1020.1

In ¶ 2 change “less than 23 days notice” to “less than 21 days notice” and “less than 5 business days notice” to “less than 7 days notice.”

0 In Exhibit A, edit the date blanks for the year to show “20__” instead of “200_.” (two instances)

0 In Exhibit B, edit the date blank for the year to show “20__” instead of “200_.”

0 In Exhibit C, edit the date blank for the year to show “20__” instead of “200_.”

0 In Exhibit D, edit the date blank for the year to show “20__” instead of “200_.”

In Exhibit E, ¶ 2, change “at least 23 days after the filing/service” to “at least 21 days after the filing/service.”

In Exhibit E, ¶ 4, change “less than 23-day notice” to “less than 21 days notice.”

In Exhibit J, item (d) on number 12 on the last page of the checklist should be changed from “have 15 days elapsed” to “have 14 days elapsed.”

In Exhibit J, edit the date blanks for the year on the signature line to show "20__" instead of "200_."

In "Comments to Cash Collateral and DIP Financing Checklist," item (e) on number 1 should be changed from "Bankruptcy Rule 4001 (b) and (c) limit the extent to which the court may grant relief on less than 15 days' notice" to "Bankruptcy Rule 4001 (b) and (c) limit the extent to which the court may grant relief on less than 14 days' notice."

Appendix L -2014

Change "If no timely response is filed within twenty (20) days" to "If no timely response is filed within twenty-one (21) days"

Appendix L -7016-a

Change Item (c) on number 2 from "within 10 days" to "within 14 days"

Change number 6 from "not later than 5 calendar days prior to docket call" to "not later than 7 calendar days prior to docket call."

In number 6, change "See Bankruptcy Local Rule 7016 (g)(3)" to "See Bankruptcy Local Rule 7016 (f)(3)."

Appendix L -9022

Change suspension (obj. language) options 10 day, 15 day, 20 day, and 60 day to 7 day, 14 day, 21 day, and 60 day.
