




STANDING ORDER REPEALING INTERIM BANKRUPTCY RULE 5012

Whereas, on October 17, 2005, this Court issued its Standing Order Adopting Interim Bankruptcy Rules to implement substantive and procedural changes mandated by the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005; and

Whereas, the Interim Rules were superseded by amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure that took effect on December 1, 2008; and

Whereas, on December 2, 2008, this Court issued Standing Order Partially Repealing Standing Orders Adopting Interim Bankruptcy Rules, pursuant to which the Court vacated its adoption of the Interim Rules as Local Rules save and except for Interim Rule 5012; and

Whereas, Interim Rule 5012 was not retained by the current amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and so was impliedly revoked by those same rules;

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. section 2071, Rule 83 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 9029 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedures, Standing Order Adopting Interim Bankruptcy Rules (Order No. 05-02) is repealed in its entirety, including the previously retained Interim Rule 5012.
